# What is the Novlee Mail and Parcel Detector, and how does it work?

The Novlee Mail and Parcel Detector is a compact, standalone device that you place inside your mailbox to effortlessly make it "smart" and connected.

It notifies you in real-time on your phone whenever mail or a package is delivered to your mailbox and when it is retrieved. This eliminates unnecessary trips to check your mailbox and allows you to:

- Track mail and package deliveries.
- Deter potential theft.

# **Key Features:**

From the Novlee mobile app, you can:

- Access a history of deliveries and retrievals.
- Configure your detectors.
- Add multiple detectors for different mailboxes.

# Notifications:

You can receive alerts on your phone in several ways:

- Directly through the Novlee mobile app.
- Via instant push notifications.

# How Does It Work?

The detector uses LPWAN technology and the Sigfox Unabiz network to communicate. Your smartphone must be connected to the Internet to view events and receive notifications.

# WARNING: Installation Instructions

THIS DETECTOR MUST BE INSTALLED IN A MAILBOX. THIS DETECTOR SUITABLE FOR MOUNTING AT HEIGHT <= 2 meters.

# WARNING: Do Not Attempt Repairs

Do not attempt to disassemble, open, repair, or modify the product or its accessories. Any signs of tampering, opening, or modification of this device, or removal of a label, will void the warranty.

# WARNING: Battery Safety



If you suspect that a child has swallowed the batteries, seek medical attention immediately. If the battery compartment is open, keep children away from the product or immediately close the compartment.

Use only new 1.5V AAA batteries.

# Installing the Mail and Parcel Detector

# STEP 0

Download the Novlee mobile app and create an account.

# **STEP 1** Scan the QR code located on the back of the detector.

# STEP 2

Insert the 3 batteries into the detector. Make sure to observe the correct polarities.

# STEP 3

Remove the protective backing from one of the Velcro mounting strips. Attach this strip to the back, at the top of your detector.



# STEP 4

Remove the protective backing from the second Velcro mounting strip, then press it firmly against the other Velcro piece.



#### ETAPE 5

#### **Important Step:**

Attach the detector to the back wall of your mailbox, centered, ensuring that the bottom edge of the detector rests on the floor of the mailbox. If there is a small ledge, attach it as low as possible.

#### Place as close to the floor as shown in the picture.

You can also attach the detector to the inside of the front door in the same manner.

#### **Important Note:**

If your mailbox has an anti-humidity mat or honeycomb grid, attach the detector to the back wall of the mailbox, ensuring it is elevated by at least the thickness of the mat or grid.

# STEP 6

# **Critical Step:**

Press the button on the left side of your detector once. As soon as the green LED starts blinking, immediately close the mailbox door.






# Wait for the detector to initialize

This process takes approximately 30–60 seconds.

# STEP 7

The app will notify you that you will be alerted for mail and parcels and will prompt you to enable notifications on your phone.





# **Important Notes:**

#### **Testing Detection:**

Avoid performing detection tests too frequently, as this may cause abnormal behavior. The program is optimized for normal mailbox usage. Wait **at least 1 minute** between each detection or action (e.g., depositing and retrieving mail).

# How to Perform a New Calibration or Change Mailboxes

If you experience detection issues or wish to move your detector to a different mailbox, follow these steps for re-initialization/calibration:

- 1. Press the button on the left side of the detector.
- 2. Immediately close the mailbox.
- 3. Wait **2 minutes** for the system to reset and recalibrate.

#### **Understanding Notifications:**

- "A letter is waiting for you"  $\rightarrow$  You have mail in your mailbox.
- "A package is waiting for you"  $\rightarrow$  You have a package in your mailbox.
- "Your mailbox is empty"  $\rightarrow$  Your mailbox has just been emptied by you or someone else.

# **Notification Timing:**

After detection, notifications are typically delivered within **30 seconds to 1 minute**.

# **Changing the Batteries**

- 1. Detach the Novlee detector from its mounting location.
- 2. Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the detector.
- 3. Replace the batteries with 3 new AAA (LR03) batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
- 4. Close the battery cover and reattach the detector in its original position.
- 5. Press the black button on the left side once, and immediately close the mailbox when the green LED blinks.

**Reminder:** Recycle used batteries in designated recycling bins. Do not dispose of them with household waste.

# Mobile App Features:

# Setting Up Your Novlee Detector:

- 1. On the homepage, click the three dots in the top-right corner of your detector.
- 2. Access the settings to:
  - Rename the detector.
  - Update the address.
  - Change the detector's logo.

# Managing Your Novlee Account:

- 1. On the homepage, click the profile button:
  - Update your first name/nickname, associated email, or password.
  - Log out of your account.
  - Delete your account.

# **Viewing Your Reception History:**

- 1. On the homepage, click on your detector.
- 2. The history of mail and parcel receptions will appear.

# Adding Another Detector to Your Account:

1. On the homepage, click "Add a Novlee" and follow the installation steps.

# Removing a Detector to Associate It with Another Account:

- 1. On the homepage, click the three dots in the top-right corner of your detector.
- 2. Select "Remove my detector" to unpair it.
